1. Hearing on the request from Eat Westgate Food Inc. dba Charley's Philly Steaks for a Common Victualer license at 200 Westgate Drive – Space E113.

Present were Dexi Liu, 8794 19th Avenue, Brooklyn, NY and Youqin Wu, 87 Willard Street, Quincy.

Mr. Liu stated he is looking forward to running the restaurant in the City of Brockton. This is a franchise operation which is coming into this area. There are several others opening in nearby cities and towns. It is located inside the Westgate Mall near Popeyes Chicken. They plan to open within the next week or so. He is hoping to get all of the inspections in next week. They want to have a few tables so customers can sit and eat the food there. Ms. Tucker stated the license can't be issued until all of the inspection approvals are completed and returned to the office.

A motion was made by Commissioner Merian to approve the Common Victualer license which motion was seconded by Commissioner DeAndrade and made unanimous by vote of Chairman Tartaglia.
