

MINUTES
PARK COMMISSION
MEETING OF THURSDAY, JUNE 11TH, 2015

The Park Commission held its monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11th, 2015 at their office located at 45 Meadow Lane, Brockton, MA. There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Harold Marrow. Present were Commissioners Chickie Studenski, Bill Keane, Billy Anderson and Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter. Commissioner Chris Connolly being absent.

Present: Lynn Smith, Kimberly E. Zouzova of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority and Malika Brown of Brockton, MA.

Motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to accept the minutes of the May 14th, 2015 and May 22nd, 2015 meetings as written. Motion carried.

A presentation and discussion was held by Kimberly Zouzova of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority with Lynn Smith for an improvement project at Mulberry Street Playground. The project would be maintained and supplied by the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to grant permission to the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority for an improvement project at the Mulberry Street Playground. Motion carried.

A recess was granted at 7:20 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:25 p.m.

Superintendent Carpenter reported on various Park issues such as that Park Association Benches unveiling was last weekend which the tower was open from 1:00 to 4:00 and that all Park irrigation systems are up and running. City Hall Plaza project should be completed by the end of June. Mulberry Street Opening is slated for September.


The Manning Pool is scheduled to be opened on June 29th and the Cosgrove is scheduled for July 3rd. The Cosgrove Pool's expansion joints have been rechaulked.

The Park Commissioners received and reviewed the legal opinion pertaining to Children's "Bouncy Houses". The legal opinion justified the long standing Park Commission's rule of not allowing any Children's "Bouncy Houses" on Park property.

A discussion was held on the condition of D.W. Field Golf Course. Superintendent Carpenter reported that the May's revenues were \$123,500 compared to \$101,400 last May. The 14 year average is approximately \$101,135. FY15 revenues as of the end of May were \$629,538 compared to FY14 revenue at \$604,426. The revenue has increased 6 percent. He stated that the cart path near 18 has been refurbished and that twenty two irrigation heads needs to be repaired. The City's Four-ball is scheduled for June 22nd.

Having no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Keane to adjourn the meeting at 7:52PM.
