OLD BUSINESS

1. **CORNER OF JON DRIVE AND SULLY ROAD**

Request received from Councilor Jack Lally on behalf of the residents at the corner of John and Sully who would like to see two more crosswalks at the intersection.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

2. **INTERSECTION OF COE/UPTON/AMARK AND DAGMAR**

Request received from Councilor Jack Lally on behalf of the residents around the intersection between Coe Road, Upton Street, Amark Road, and Dagmar Drive who would like the intersection to become a four way stop.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: PLACE "HILL BLOCKS VIEW" SIGN BY POLE #7 ON AMARK ROAD FOR WESTBOUND TRAFFIC.

3. **CORNER OF BROOKVILLE AVENUE & RANDOLPH AVENUE**

Request received from Councilor Jack Lally from the residents at the corner of Brookville Ave and Randolph Ave who would like a three way stop there to slow down traffic on Brookville.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: MOVE NORTHWEST CORNER STOP SIGN ON JON DRIVE FOR BETTER VISIBILITY. REFER TO TRAFFIC FOR ENFORCEMENT.

4. **MONTILIO'S BAKERY**

Request received from Councilor Jack Lally from Montilio's Bakery who would like a review of their parking situation, and if anything can be done to fix it.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: PLACE A "NO PARKING BEYOND THIS POINT" SIGN WITH ARROW.

5. **ALGER STREET**

Request received from Councilor-At-Large Moises Rodrigues on behalf of resident Janderson Rodrigues of 153 Alger Street to have some speed limit signs posted on Alger Street. He has small children and states that the cars fly by as if they were on the highway.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT SIGN AT POLE #153 FOR SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC AND ON POLE #30 FOR NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC.

6. **INTERSECTION OF WALNUT STREET & WYMAN STREET**

Request received from Councilor Tom Monahan on behalf of the residents in the area who would like to discuss what can be done at this intersection as they feel it is a safety issue and are concerned about the amount of accidents.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: LEAVE AS IS. ALL SIGNAGE IS VISIBLE.

7. **DOVER STREET & ROCKY MARCIANO WAY**

Request received from Councilor Monahan on behalf of Mark Casieri who is concerned about vehicles running the stop signs.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: MOVE STOP SIGN ON MARCIANO WAY TO ITS OWN POLE.

8. **TREMONT STREET**

Request received from Councilor Studenski on behalf of residents on Tremont Street who would like the "No Parking" signs replaced that were previously on one side of the street.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

9. **19 LIBBY STREET**

Request received from Councilor-At-Large Winthrop Farwell on behalf of Patricia LaBate who resides at 19 Libby Street for "NO PARKING" signs in front of her house. She lives in the area of the newly constructed Signature Health Medical Facility Building and indicates that she is the last residential home in that area. Her concern is that patients or staff may park in front of her home making it difficult for her to enter/exit her driveway, etc.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: “NO PARKING” ON EAST SIDE OF LIBBY STREET FROM CENTRE STREET TO QUINCY AVENUE. “NO PARKING” ON WEST SIDE OF LIBBY STREET FROM CENTRE STREET TO HOSPITAL ENTRANCE.

10. **GALEN STREET**

Request made by Councilor Anne Beauregard to get a “Dead End or Not a Through Way” sign on Galen Street.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

11. **WEST CHESTNUT STREET AT STEWART AVENUE**

Request received from Councilor Dennis Eaniri for a Stop sign at West Chestnut Street at Stewart Avenue, heading west.

12. **PEARL STREET**

Request received from Councilor Dennis Eaniri on behalf of some residents on Pearl Street For 2 signs going north and south to read:

1. *“NO ENGINE BRAKE - NO JAKE BRAKE”*

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: REFER TO LAW DEPARTMENT.

13. **LILY AVENUE & WEST CHESTNUT STREET**

Request received from Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have a “No Parking From Here To Corner” sign at Lily Avenue and West Chestnut Street, heading west as drivers cannot see coming out of Lily Avenue taking a left onto West Chestnut Street.

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: PLACE “NO PARKING CORNER TO HERE” IN FRONT OF #122 MARKET STREET.

14. **CORNER OF 1170 WARREN AVENUE AND 74 MARKET STREET**

Request received from Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have a guardrail put up at 1170 Warren Avenue at the corner of Warren Avenue and 74 Market Street as the resident’s house has been hit several times in the past 2 years.
