

SNOW SHOVELING PROGRAM FOR BROCKTON SENIORS 60+

“Guidelines”

GOAL: Create employment opportunities for our youth while providing much needed support of our senior citizens (60 years or older) and people with mobility challenges.

1. Pilot program based on funding/ youth and other resources.
2. Number of residents in program is based upon availability of youth.
3. Program will only run with 4 or more inches of snow.
4. Youth will respond within 4 hours of storm completion.
5. For the safety and well being of our youth, they will not be allowed to shovel for more than 2 hours if the temperature outside is between and 10 and 20 degrees or more than an 1 hour if temperature is 10 degrees or less.
6. Agreed upon fee is paid, in full, to youth at the completion of the job.
7. Youth are NOT allowed to enter homes, please leave payment and completion card in the envelope we will send you. Please leave envelope in an accessible area on your doorstep, mailbox, driveway, etc.
8. If homeowner decides last minute they want something else shoveled while person is there, they must call the Snow Shoveling Program coordinator at the Council on Aging at 508-580-7811.
9. In the case of an extremely heavy snowfall, price may differ and/or your match person may not be able to do the jobs.
10. Shovelers are NOT allowed to use snow blowers or other mechanical equipment provided by the homeowner.
11. Snow removal from automobiles on the property is the responsibility of the homeowner.
