Present was Manager Paul J. Fuhs of 33 Loring Street Brockton, Ma 02302; Jon D. Aieta of Cassis & Cayer- 18 Russell Park, Quincy, MA 02169.

It was said that Paul was the former owner of Dylan back in 2013 and was run successfully for 3 years. In 2016, Paul decided to walk away from the business part of the bar but was still the owner of the business. His brothers took over and were unsuccessful due to abandoning business and now Paul would like to take over the business again. Mr. Fuhs is TIP certified and would also like a 2 a.m. closing.
