
AN ORDER AMENDING LICENSING AND BUSINESS REGULATIONS FOR MARIJUANA BUSINESSES

Section 1.009 (b) (2) of the licensing and business regulations is hereby amended by inserting the following at the end of the section:

“Notwithstanding any other requirement, no transfer of a license shall be considered by the city council unless the licensee’s business shall have been open and in operation during normal business hours for a period of one calendar year (three hundred and sixty-five days) prior to the date of request to transfer said license.”



ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REVISED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROCKTON, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 6-2 COMPOSITION

That Chapter 6, Article 1, Section 6-2 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Brockton be amended to increase the number of Fire Department Captains by one (1), from seventeen (17) to eighteen (18), for a limited period of time, subject to a sunset clause, as set forth below:

Section 6-2(b) Eighteen Captains.

The increase in the number of Captains in the Fire Department shall be for a limited time only. The additional position of an Eighteenth(18th) Captain, as set forth in this Amendment, shall be eliminated and the number of captains allowed in the Fire Department shall revert back to seventeen (17) immediately upon a vacancy occurring in said title for any reason, including but not limited to, the termination, resignation, retirement, promotion, or any other separation from employment by any one (1) of the eighteen (18) captains of the Fire Department.
