SPECIAL PROVISIONS

In case permission is granted, and in consideration of the same, the contractor agrees to light and barricade the street at night in a manner sufficient to secure the safety of passengers thereon; and when the occupancy for said purpose shall cease, the contractor agrees to leave said street unencumbered by any debris whatever, and he further agrees to fully indemnify the City of Brockton against all claims for damages or injuries to persons or property, and against all suits and losses occasioned by or arising from such opening and occupancy of said street; he further agrees to pay all costs and damages which may be recovered against the City of Brockton by reason or on account of such digging up and opening of the grounds in said street. **This permit must be kept at the site where the work is being performed.**

All street openings and/or utility installations must be performed by a contractor possessing an up to date **Department of Public Works Construction License**, and shall be in accordance with the City Ordinance which is referenced herein. All backfilling and pavement restoration methods shall be as directed by the Department of Public Works Operations Division, Highway Section, and the aforementioned ordinance.

The contractor will be responsible for condition and maintenance of the road surface for a period of at least one (1) year from the date of installation of the permanent patch, and will continue to hold the City of Brockton safe from any claims resulting from his work during the one year period.

The contractor's attention is hereby directed to the **Revised Ordinances of the City of Brockton; Chapter 20, Article II, STREET OPENING BY-LAW**, Sec. 20-39 through Sec. 20-51, and **Article III, PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION LICENSE BY-LAW**, Sec. 20-100 through Sec. 20-105, inclusive, referred to herein and made a part of this permit.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the contractor to provide a minimum of 72 hours advance notice to the DPW Operations Division, Highway Section at 508-580-7810, and to the DPW Utilities Division, Water and Sewer Sections at 508-580-7865, and to the Fire Department Signal Division (fire alarms, fiber & traffic signals) at 508-583-2323, prior to commencing work.

COMMENTS: **Controlled density (flowable) fill** is required for all excavations within the street or sidewalk layout. _____

NOTE: All work performed must be by the licensee. If the work is to be subcontracted, said subcontractor must also obtain a Public Works Construction License.

For specific pavement restoration requirements the contractor's attention is directed to the previously referenced City Ordinance. Copies may be obtained at the office of the DPW Engineering Division.
