f. Taverns and restaurants including drive-in type.

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AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO RESTAURANTS AND OUTDOOR DINING

The following amendment to the pending Ordinance is hereby moved:

"Section 27-29, C-2 zones, general commercial zones, Paragraph 3, Special Permitted Uses is hereby amended by adding the following sections after section "f":

g. An applicant for a special permitted use shall provide to the Zoning Board of Appeals a plan identifying location and numbers of tables and, if applicable, a suitable barrier to protect patrons from vehicles. The Zoning Board of Appeals may establish such other conditions not inconsistent with the safety and welfare of patrons using outdoor dining services.

h. Prior to use, the building department shall perform an inspection to ensure compliance with state regulations or any condition imposed by the Zoning Board of Appeals."
