

MINUTES
PARK COMMISSION
MEETING OF THURSDAY, OCTOBER 8th, 2020

The Park Commission held their Meeting at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 8th, 2020 in their office, 45 Meadow Lane, Brockton, MA VIA VIRTUAL ZOOM MEETING. There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Keane. Present were Commissioner Kevin Borges, Commissioner Chickie Studenski, Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter and Administrative Assistant Rene' Brown. Commissioner Billy Anderson and Commissioner Ulisses Varela being absent.

Present: Paul Coutoumas, Performance Golf Management, Inc.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Borges to accept the minutes of the June 11th, 2020 meeting. Motion carried.

A discussion was held on the extension of the one year option for the Golf Management Services Contract (PK19-100).


A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Borges to extend the one year option of the Golf Management Services Contract. Motion carried.

Superintendent Carpenter reported to the Commission of the Governor's updated COVID19 restrictions for Golf Courses. Non-household people are now allowed to share a cart. Due to a limited amount of available carts, maximum allowed is three carts per foursome. Single Cart rates are \$25.00 at this time. Rakes and flagsticks are allowed by the state, but we have chosen not to allow such items. The Pro Shop and Lunchroom are being sanitized by an Electric Static Sanitizer.

As for Golf Course's revenues, we have had the highest September ever. \$65,000 increase from last September. The Year to Date amount is \$1.25 million; which is up \$242,000 over last year. The Golf Course is on target to have the highest grossing year ever in its history. It is scheduled to close the December 1, 2020.

Having no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Borges to adjourn the meeting at 7:14 PM. Motion carried.
