ORDINANCE:

An Ordinance Amending Part II of the Revised Ordinances, Chapter 21

“Taxicabs, Buses, etc.”

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Brockton:

Section 21-11(a) shall be amended by striking the word “shall” and inserting in its place “may” so that the revised ordinance reads “All taxicabs in the city may display an ‘identity light’ on top of the taxi cab...”;

Section 21-15 shall be amended by striking the words “one-quarter (1/4)” and inserting in its place “one-eighth (1/8)” so that the revised ordinance reads “Effective on April 1, 2009, not less than one-eighth (1/8) of a licensee’s vehicle to which a license applies shall be equipped with safety shields...”; and

Section 21-32(3)(b) shall be deleted in its entirety.


Section 1.004(1)(h) is amended by inserting the following sentence to the end of section 1.004(1)(h):

“This section limiting the number of recreational retail marijuana licenses shall not apply to an RMD that was provisionally licensed not later than July 1, 2017.”

Be it further ordained by the City Council of the City of Brockton as follows:

That the language “Intentionally omitted” in Section 1.005 be stricken and the following language be inserted in its place, so that the following language replaces Section 1.005 in its entirety:

“Upon such time as the City Council has granted all available recreational retail marijuana licenses pursuant to subsection 1.004(1)(h), the Clerk of the City Council shall no longer accept any new applications for a recreational retail marijuana license. Notice shall be given in writing to any applicant with a pending application notifying the applicant that there are no available recreational retail marijuana licenses. If any recreational retail marijuana licenses become available in the City of Brockton, the City Clerk shall post notice of the same on the City website and by posting notice of the same in City Hall.”






