

MINUTES
LICENSE COMMISSION MEETING
6:00 p.m.
Thursday, February 4, 2021
Virtual ZOOM Meeting
Brockton, Massachusetts

The License Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, February 4, 2021 in VIA ZOOM. Present were Commissioners Jeffrey Charnel, David Teixeira, and Paul Studenski. Also present were License Agent Paul Bonanca, and Executive Assistant Silvia Carvalho.

1. Approval of the Minutes of the License Commission Meeting of December 21, 2020.

A motion was made by Commissioner Teixeira to approve the minutes of the aforesaid meetings which motion was seconded by Commissioner Studenski and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

2. Approval of the following police officers as license agents for the month of February 2021: Lieuts. Paul Bonanca and David Farrell; Sgts. George Khoury and Christopher McDermott; Dets. Patrick Donahue, Erin Cummings, Jackie Congdon, Eric Clark, Santiago Cirino, Thomas Hyland, Michael Bunker, Nazaire Paul, James Cronshaw and Timothy Stanton.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski to approve the license agents as listed for the month of February 2021. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Teixeira and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

3. Hearing on a request from Doyle's On the Green, LLC for a Seasonal Permit to Sell Wine and Malt Beverages and a Common Victualer license to be used at D.W. Field Golf-331 Oak Street, Brockton, MA.

Present was Ana Ferrari of 229 Vernon Street, Bridgewater, MA.

Ms. Ferrari informed the board that she has worked there for the last three years and she won the bid to provide the beer and wine. The employees will remain the same as last year with no changes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski to approve the licenses. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Teixeira and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

4. Hearing on a request from Blazin Wings, Inc. dba Buffalo Wild Wings for a Change of Manager on an All Alcoholic Beverages Restaurant license located at 500 Westgate Drive, SC 101, Brockton, MA.

Present was Mr. Vinnie Gomes of 32 Godfrey Street, Apt#2, Taunton, MA.

Mr. Gomes informed the board that he is taking over as the new general manager because the old one went to their Mansfield location. The board asked Mr. Gomes if he had experience and he replied yes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski to approve the change. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Teixeira and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

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5. Hearing on a request from Ambe Liquors, Inc. dba Super Value Liquors for a reconsideration on an Issuance/Transfer of Stock/New Stockholder on an All Alcoholic Beverages Package Store license located at 597 Centre Street, Brockton, MA.

Present was Attorney Ian Hedges of 480 Turnpike Street, South Easton, MA.

Attorney Hedges informed the board that his client was before the board in October of last year and the ABCC needed additional clarification on the shareholders, and that is what he is submitting to the board for approval.

A motion was made by Commissioner Teixeira to approve the additional documents. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Studenski and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

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6. Hearing on a request from Hanuman Corporation dba Roses Discount Liquors for a reconsideration on an Issuance/Transfer of Stock/New Stockholder on an All Alcoholic Beverages Package Store license located at 186 Oak Street, Unit #2A, Brockton, MA.

Present was Attorney Ian Hedges of 480 Turnpike Street, South Easton, MA.

Attorney Hedges informed the board that this is the previous agenda item, and it is for the same client, the ABCC needed clarification on the shareholders.

A motion was made by Commissioner Studenski to approve the additional documents. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Teixeira and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

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7. Hearing on a request from Akshar Shanley Inc. for a reconsideration on a Transfer of License on an All Alcoholic Beverages Package Store license located at 429 Belmont Street, Brockton, MA.
8. Hearing on a request from Akshar Westside Inc. for a reconsideration on a Transfer of License and a Change of location on an All Alcoholic Beverages Package Store license located at 104 Torrey Street moving to 641-651 Belmont Street, Brockton, MA.

Present was Attorney William Kelley of One Beacon Street, 22ND Fl Boston, MA, Domingos Daveiga of 36 Cosma Road, North Easton, MA and Parth Amin of 114 Torrey Street, Brockton, MA.

Attorney Kelley informed the board that both owners are on the call. The applications have been approved by the Brockton License Commission and the ABCC. The original application was submitted by a different attorney and there were corrections that needed to be made, and requests for additional documents. Attorney Kelley informed the board that he has made the necessary corrections and included the amendments required by the ABCC and requested that the board approve of them. The changes were the source of financing, the circumstances had changed, and a private party would be the source making it a four-part transaction for two package stores. The loan is unsecured, and they are not asking for a Pledge of the license at this time and will come back before the board if needed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Teixeira to approve the additional documents and corrections on both items # 8 and # 9 on the agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Studenski and made unanimous by vote of the members present.

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9. Hearing on a request from Bertucci's Restaurants, LLC dba Bertucci's for a Change of Manager on an All Alcoholic Beverages Restaurant license located at 1285 Belmont Street, Brockton, MA.

There was no one present for the meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Teixeira to table the agenda item until the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Studenski and made unanimous by vote of the members present.
