Statement from Mayor Robert Sullivan regarding Tropical Storm Henri
Tropical Storm to hit Brockton late Sunday afternoon

“As Tropical Storm Henri makes its way towards Massachusetts, I strongly urge all residents to make all of the necessary preparations and to stay inside and off the street roads if possible this Sunday. I encourage everyone to bring all 'loose items' indoors (trash barrels, lawn signs, etc.), purchase 3 days' worth of water, purchase nonperishable foods, candles, and batteries, and make sure all prescribed medicines have been refilled. The Brockton Emergency Management Agency (BEMA) will continue tracking the storm and will provide up-to-date information on their social media accounts @BrocktonEMA on Facebook and @Brockton_EMA on Twitter. You may also call BEMA at (508)-580-7871 or check the City website for regular storm updates. This is a serious storm and the more prepared you are the better off you will be.
