Brockton Assembly of God gives generous flag donation to Brockton

The church donated \$3,000 dollars for the replacement of all the flags owned by the City

BROCKTON, MA – The Brockton Assembly of God church, will be recognized this **Friday, December 3rd, at City Hall Plaza** for its generous donation of new flags to the City. This event will take place at 1:30 pm.

The Parks and Recreations Department will have a ladder on sight at City Hall Plaza and will raise the first of the new flags to commemorate the occasion.

On October 25th, a \$3,000 donation from Brockton Assembly of God to the Mayor’s Office was accepted by the City Council for the replacement of each flag owned by the City.

Pastor Steven Warner of the Brockton Assembly of God was the driving force behind the donation.

“Upon realizing how weathered the flags on display at City Hall were, I decided to inquire about what it would take to place them,” said Pastor Warner. “There is a lot of patriotism and pride that is attached with one’s flag of origin. The Brockton Assembly of God is happy to do its part to bolster those feelings within the various ethnic groups of the City.”
