# BROCKTON – Intersection Improvements and Related Work at Centre Street (Route 123), Cary Street and Lyman Street

## What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Intersection Improvements and Related Work at Centre Street (Route 123), Cary Street and Lyman Street Project in Brockton, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

## How will this affect you?

The project intersection is included on MassDOT's list of the Top 200 high-crash locations statewide in recent years. The lack of left-turn lanes causes safety concerns resulting in angle and rear-end crashes as well as congestion, delaying emergency vehicles traveling to and from the nearby Brockton Hospital. The existing pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure needs improvement. The curb radii are too small to accommodate all vehicles. The Project proposes to reconstruct the intersection to provide left-turn lanes on Route 123, replace the signal equipment to provide overhead indications, and upgrade pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure to meet current standards.
