

MINUTES
PARK COMMISSION
MEETING OF MONDAY, JUNE 13TH, 2022

The Park Commission held their Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 13th, 2022 in their office, 45 Meadow Lane, Brockton, MA and VIA VIRTUAL ZOOM MEETING. There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Keane. Present were Commissioner Charles Studenski, Commissioner Billy Anderson, Commissioner Ulisses Varela, Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter, and Head Clerk Rene Brown. Commissioner Kevin Borges being absent.

Motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to accept the minutes of the May 12th, 2022 meeting. Motion carried.

Superintendent Carpenter reported on the Golf Course. The golf course's revenue for May, 2022 were \$234,209 which is up from \$190,964 in May, 2021. The average for May is \$122,124. May 2022 was the best on record. The year to date total is \$508,468 which is up from \$498,325 in 2021. Conditions have improved due to the warm weather. There was a break in at the clubhouse. Entrance was made by a broken window. Police responded, report has been filed. The contract for the cart paths is in the works and the Bid specs for the netting project should be coming in shortly. The golf course held the City's four ball a week ago.

Superintendent Carpenter reported on the parks and pools. The Manning Pool has been painted, repairs to the concrete and chaulking has been completed. June 25th is the scheduled opening day. Cosgrove Pool is in the process of being repainted. The Old Colony Y will staff the lifeguards and it is scheduled to open around July 1st. Edgar, Nelson Playground and Ash St Park have continued to have unpermitted use in which damage was done to a league's portapotties at Ash Street. Soccer Nets have been installed at O'Donnell's Playground. We have received numerous reports from the residents that Brockton Sunday League has been leaving East Middle School in unacceptable condition pertaining to trash. Superintendent Carpenter has contacted the league president about the Rules & Regulations that he agreed to. Keith Park Fountain was started up. Mass Wildlife will be having a Learn to Fish free clinic on June 25th at Waldo from 10:00 to Noon. A promotional video by the Mayor's office will be shot at DW Field Golf course on June 25th.


The Park Department Budget has been approved as submitted. Replacement of two trucks would include a pickup and a dump truck. The DW Field Park Association is planning movie nights for the Saturdays in August, a fishing derby and would like to open the tower once a month.

Chairman Keane asked for a moment to inform the Park Commission that he is resigning. The Park Commission recognized Chairman Keane for his 10 years of service to the Commission.

Motion was made by Commissioner Anderson and seconded by Commissioner Varela to nominate Commissioner Studenski as Chairman of the Park Commission. Motion carried.

Having no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Varela and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 PM. Motion carried.
