MINUTES

The Traffic held a Special meeting via Zoom at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 21, 2022.

Present were Traffic Commissioners: Traffic Commissioner Captain Mark Porcaro, Retired Chief Kenneth Galligan, Director Stephen Hooke, Councilor Shirley Asack, Councilor at Large Mendes and Mr. James Sweeney and DPW Commissioner Patrick Hill.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Eastern Bank - NORTH MAIN STREET

Requested by: Lorenzo Vigil

Issue/ Request: looking for 15-20 on-street parking spots for crew and trucks for filming of a commercial

Discussion: present was Mr. Lorenzo Vigil. He is looking for 12 parking spots to park 3 box trucks, 1 panel van, 1 transportation van and 1 SUV comfortably without disturbing neighbors. Mr. Virgil would prefer to have them parked on North Main Street in front of the store and across the street as well. Commissioner Galligan had a few questions such as if the vehicles will be on one side? Mr. Vigil stated he would like to have the vehicles all on one side for safety reasons. Manners was also a suggestion for parking but Mr. Vigil stated he will need that side cleared for filming reasons. If parking were to take place on Manners, "No Parking" signs would have to be posted. Councilor Asack asked, "what time was filming?" Mr. Vigil responded filming is taking place between 6am and 9am. She also brought up the complaints of parking and asked if they will notify the residents. Mr. Vigil stated yes, the residents will be notified. Councilor Asack also asked if the truck needs to be close by and Mr. Vigil responded yes, it needs to be close by for equipment usage. Councilor Asack suggested if she could secure parking in one of the neighboring store parking lots, if that would help. Mr. Vigil responded yes, it would help but will still need the 12 parking spots. Eddie, DPW sign maintenance, will bring out the barricades the day before.
