ORDINANCES:

4. Ordinance: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II, DIVISION 3, SECTION 2-91
Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Brockton as follows: Article II, Section 2-91, entitled "Committees generally" is hereby amended by inserting the following:
Section (g): Committee on Economic Development to consist of five (5) members to consider matters pertaining to economic development. The committee shall review economic development initiatives, grant applications pending or filed, potential development projects, and report to the council on such matters. The committee shall receive a written, quarterly report from the director of planning and economic development on department activities. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other ordinance, the committee may meet at the call of the chair with the planning and economic development department and such other departments as needed to carry out its responsibilities.
5. Ordinance: Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Brockton as follows:
That the City Council adopt the following Ordinance relative to Recreational Vehicles in the City of Brockton: Full Ordinance is available for viewing in the Clerk's Office.

6. Order: Rules and Regulations governing motor vehicles for hire under Chapter 159A for the carrying of passengers.

7. Order: Assessors to act as agents of City Council in matter of apportionment of betterments.
8. Order: Clerk to give notice of hearings before Council.
9. Order: Regulations governing the operation of hawkers and peddlers within the City of Brockton.
10. Order: Pawnbrokers are to deliver a list of purchased/pawned articles to the Chief of Police.
