Old business: The GIS project is moving forward. It is currently being utilized by the Planning Department and D.P.W. They are working on resolving an issue with some licensing in regards to merging data to a shared file.

The School Department's cameras are in process of uploading to the server. Neal is working on firewalls which will more than double the storage. More cameras are being added around City Hall. They're all configured and waiting for the contractors to install them.

The IT Center has two new hires, Adam Mello and Anthony Savage. The Chairman stated they both have been wonderful additions to the department. There is an additional job opening which was posted internally and there were no applicants. The job is set to go out to the public very soon.

New business: Multi-factor authentication is now active for the IT Center. It asks security questions when signing for added security. The Chairman has to notify the Chief of Staff before rolling it out to all users because it will temporarily slow down the workflow.

The IT Center has asked to push back the Munis upgrade because there is an issue adding a new user.
