Brockton's federal delegation to announce nearly \$10.4 million in federal funding for projects throughout the City

BROCKTON – The Massachusetts congressional delegation, including U.S. Representative Stephen Lynch, and U.S. Senators Elizabeth Warren and Edward Markey will be visiting the City of Brockton Friday, February 24.

Mayor Robert F. Sullivan will welcome the lawmakers to Brockton City Hall to celebrate approximately \$11 million in federal funds for projects throughout the City, including:

- \$3 million for the renovation of the Lawrence R. Cosgrove Memorial Pool
- \$2 million for the City's biosolids disposal system
- \$2.05 million for the Old Colony YMCA's pilot program to increase access to family engagement and education services
- \$2 million for NeighborWorks Housing Solutions' 1200 Montello Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) project
- \$1 million for Brockton Hospital/Signature Healthcare's efforts to expand behavioral health beds in its emergency room
- \$337,000 for Family and Community Resources, Inc. to increase capacity at its mental health clinic
- \$1 million for Brockton Neighborhood Health Center to convert administrative offices into clinical space to accommodate six primary care providers, and increase substance-use disorder services

The funds will come from the FY2023 Omnibus Appropriations Bill, which was signed by President Biden.
