In City Council October 24, 2022,

1. Ordinance: An Ordinance Amending Article III, Section 2-146 – Compensation – School Committee members elected by Ward is hereby amended by striking the words “five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)” and inserting in its place. “fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00).” The language “The amendment shall be effective January 1, 2018” shall be amended to reflect a new effective date of January 1, 2024.

In City Council January 11, 2023,

2. Ordinance: An Ordinance Amending Article II, Section 2-91, entitled “Committees generally” by creating a City Council subcommittee for the Committee on Economic Development.

In City Council December 12, 2022

3. Ordinance: That the City Council adopt the following Amendment to Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances, Article IV, Section 2-261 “Veterans property tax work-off program” as follows: Subsection 2-261(i)(1) shall be deleted in its entirety to eliminate income limitations for applicants.
4. Ordinance: That the City Council adopt the following Amendment to Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances, Article IV, Section 2-260 “Senior citizen property tax work-off program” as

follows: Subsection 2-260(h)(1) shall be deleted in its entirety to eliminate income limitations for applicants.

In City Council December 27, 2022,

5. Ordinance: That the City Council adopt the following Amendment to Chapter 3 “Animals and Fowl” of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Brockton, replacing the entirety of Chapter 3.

In City Council January 11, 2023,

6. Ordinance: That the City Council adopt the following Ordinance relative to Recreational Vehicles in the City of Brockton.

In City Council January 23, 2023,

7. Ordinance: An Ordinance Amending Article III, Division 2, Section 2-127 – Pay Plan inserting “Conservation Commission Chair, Conservation Commission Member” to the categories of pay plan positions and establishing a per meeting flat rate.

In City Council February 27, 2023, Ordinance 1-5 passed to a third reading by a hand vote. Ordinances 6 & 7 passed to a third reading as amended by a hand vote.

In City Council March 13, 2023, Ordinances 1-5 were ordained. Ordinances 2, 6 & 7 were ordained as amended. Councilor Asack absent.
