**1. Approval of 03-21-2023 Meeting Minutes**

Geoffrey Keenan made a motion to accept the minutes from the March 21, 2023 meeting; seconded by Evan Lacasse; unanimously approved.

**2. Updates from Chair**

- The chair suggested that because of the special services of solar farms and cemetery, a 50% fee reduction should be introduced on the Stormwater Management Manual Ordinance, to be effective from the next fiscal year. Motion was moved, seconded and unanimously approved.

**3. Review of Stormwater Permit Application**

- There is an existing copy of the City of Brockton Stormwater Permit Application on the website. Chike proposed a fee charge if a hard copy of the application plans is requested, either from the project proponent or the city, to cover the cost of producing the plans.
- Signature line at the review page needs to be included for approval in the Stormwater Permit Application. Motion moved, seconded and unanimously approved.

**4. Review of Stormwater Ordinance**

- Listed on the City of Brockton Ordinance of the Stormwater Authority all buildable lots no matter the size shall comply with the Stormwater Ordinance. A motion was made, seconded and approved by unanimous vote of the members of the Authority present.
