The License Commission held a Special Meeting on Wednesday, October 25, 2023, via ZOOM. Present were, Commissioners Jeffrey Charnel, Paul Studenski, Robert P. Simpson, Christina Derome, Scott Uhlman, Executive Assistant Silvia Carvalho, and Lt. Paul Bonanca.

 Hearing on a request from Brockton Arts, Inc., for a Special One Day Permit to Sell All Alcoholic Beverages for an Art Reception and a Fundraiser to be held at the Enso Galleries-86 Centre Street, on the following dates: October 26, 2023, from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. November 18, 2023, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Present was Mr. Arnie Danielson of 603 Summer Street, Brockton, MA.

Chairman Charnel asked Mr. Danielson what he planned for those dates. Mr. Danielson informed the board that the event scheduled for October 26, 2023, was a fundraising event for School Committee member Tony Rodrigues. They will have local artists and they will be raising money for a pet project relating to the school department. The November 18, 2023, event is an Artist Reception, representing 9 artists. They expect 75-100 and will be serving light food. They are hoping to have a good time and send everyone home safe. Chairman Charnel asked if there was anyone in favor or opposition, and if there were any elected officials that wanted to be heard. He closed that portion of the hearing and opened it up to the Commissioners. Commissioner Uhlman stated that the address on the form is incorrect, and it should be 50. Mr. Danielson replied that if they put that address on the form people will go to the wrong door.

Commissioner Derome asked Mr. Danielson if it was open to the public. He replied yes, Lt. Bonanca stated that if that is so, they will need 1 police detail. Mr. Danielson was informed that he must purchase the alcohol from a Wholesaler and a Crowd Manager must be present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Simpson to take both dates collectively. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Studenksi and made unanimous by vote of the members present.
