

MINUTES
PARK COMMISSION
MEETING OF THURSDAY, MARCH 14TH, 2024

The Park Commission held their Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 14th, 2024 in their office, 45 Meadow Lane, Brockton, MA. There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Charles Studenski. Present were Commissioner Billy Anderson, Commissioner Kevin Borges, Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter and Administrative Assistant Rene' Brown. Commissioner Ulisses Varela being absent.

Motion was made by Commissioner Anderson and seconded by Commissioner Borges to accept the minutes of the February 8th, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.

A discussion was held pertaining to the subcommittee report for contract PK-RFP24-Lunchroom. The subcommittee reviewed the only submitted proposal for the operation of the lunchroom. They deemed the proposal as "highly advantageous".

Motion was made by Commissioner Anderson and seconded by Commissioner Borges to accept the report of the subcommittee and approve Doyle's on the Green's proposal for the operation of the Lunchroom at DW Field Golf Course. Motion carried.

Superintendent Carpenter reported on the DW Field Golf Course. It is scheduled to open March 22nd and the prices were changed on the website. The Lunchroom is scheduled to open April 1st. They are now deep-tining and rolling greens. The netting has been undermined due to abundant rains causing erosion at the base of the western-most pole. It has been re-cemented including more tie-downs. The replacement windows in the clubhouse has been selected and the work is to start at the end of March. A delivery truck caught the wire from the cart barn to the maintenance garage.

As for the Parks, they are getting the fields ready to play including sod cutting at the infield and outfield interface. The schools and youth permits have been completed and permits goes into effect on April 1st. The Commission inquired about Adult Soccer Leagues permitting. Chairman Studenski requested that all Adult Soccer League Permits must come before the Park Commission with a plan, including but not limiting to crowd control and trash pickup to be reviewed and approved. Pictures of the continued work at the Cosgrove Pool was shown and reported. A state appropriation of \$50,000 for Brockton Baseball will go towards Downey's dugouts and scoreboard.

Motion was made by Commissioner Borges and seconded by Commissioner Anderson to adjourn the meeting at 7:33 PM. Motion carried.
