ACTION PLAN FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND HOME PROGRAMS

This Hearing replaces the previously scheduled BRA hearing on the same date and time

The City of Brockton, Department of Planning and Economic Development will hold a public hearing requesting input from the public to determine housing and community needs; usage of available City of Brockton FY2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds. U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funds will be expended for the following types of activities: public safety, social services, economic development, public facilities, elimination of architectural barriers, demolition of condemned property, homeowner grant program, homebuyer program, and HOME housing production.

The City expects that more than 70% of the CDBG and 100% of the HOME funds will be expended on activities that benefit primarily low- and moderate-income people. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain the views of interested citizens, organizations and other parties as to the city's housing and community development needs as well as to respond to questions regarding CDBG and HOME funds in the action plan.

Persons with speech, hearing or sight disabilities and requiring translation services will be accommodated to the greatest extent possible provided a request for such assistance is made at a reasonable time prior to the hearing.
