

**INVITATION TO BID

WARREN AVENUE CONVERSION PROJECT

This project is being Electronically Bid (E-Bid). All bids shall be submitted online at www.Projectdog.com until 11:00 AM January 16, 2025. Bidders and the public may view bid results, as well as inspect bid documents via the Projectdog website or attend the in-person bid opening in the GAR Room, Second Floor, City Hall, 45 School Street, Brockton, MA 02301.

MassDOT prequalification of contractors with the class work as Highway - Construction, for the project with an estimated value of \$10,498,000 will be required.

The work of this contract includes but is not limited to of full depth roadway reclamation, full depth pavement construction, pavement milling and overlay, removing and stacking or resetting of existing granite curb, installation of new granite curb, construction of sidewalks and curb ramps as well as a raised cycle track, drainage improvements, construction of driveway aprons, loaming and seeding, installation of structural soil, flexible porous pavement (tree well surfacing), trees and plantings, installation of street lighting, installation of signs and pavement markings, safety signing for construction operations, and all incidental labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work shown on the plans or described hereinafter.

The work also consists of installing traffic control signal materials (some of which are owner-procured) including video detection, signal posts, signal heads, mast arm assemblies, cabinet pull boxes and conduit. The work under this contract includes installing foundations, wire and cable, and electrical service connections, and all other equipment, materials and incidental costs necessary to furnish, install and program a complete and functioning traffic control signal system as specified and as shown in the contract documents.

The Contract Time shall be 510 Calendar Days excluding winter shutdown which shall be enforced between Thanksgiving (November 27, 2025, and March 31, 2026) unless approved by Owner, commencing twenty days following the Effective Date of this Agreement. Intermediate course paving, and fully operational traffic signal and SMART components along Warren Avenue are required by November 26, 2025, to allow for two-way emergency vehicular traffic flow.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100 percent Performance Bond and a 100 percent Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the Owner.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

Wage rates for this Project are subject to the minimum wage rates as per M.G.L., Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H inclusive.

The bidding and award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M.

Award of this contract will be contingent on the City's needs, appropriation, and availability of funds. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids if deemed to be in its best interest.
