The License Commission held a Special Meeting on Thursday, January 23, 2025, via ZOOM. Present were, Commissioners Jeffrey Charnel, Robert P. Simpson, Scott D. Uhlman, Janet Landerholm, Katrice Gerald, Lt. David Farrell, and Administrative Assistant Synthia Olivier.

1. Hearing on a request from Father Bill's & Mainspring for a Special One Day Permit to Sell Wine and Malt Beverages for a Donor Event to be held at 124 Manley Street, on January 23, 2025, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Present was Ms. Lynn Calling of 484 Main Street, Bridgewater, MA.

Ms. Calling informed the board that this is an event to bank private supporters and they are expecting seventy guests and will be providing a tour of the center. They are working with the Fire Department to make sure everything that is needed is provided and they have the certificate. They will have a police detail as well. Chairman Charnel opened the meeting to the public and asked if there was anyone in favor or opposition, and if there were any elected officials that would like to be heard. He closed that portion of the meeting and opened it up to the Commissioners.

Commissioner Uhlman asked her where they will be purchasing the alcohol? She replied they are using Brews and Sips a catering company with a 12c license. They have worked with the company to ensure the license is in order. Lt. Farrell had no objections from the Police Department. Captain Weeks spoke to the applicants and had no objections. Chairman Charnel stated that he does not imagine any issues.

Chairman Charnel stated that he was a member, but he is no longer on the board and will be able to advise and can provide a decision. They are hosting an event at Soiree District on February 19, 2025, and Brockton Beer will be providing the beer and wine. This is a two-hour event and they are selling tickets with a cap of thirty-five people. Chairman Charnel opened the meeting to the public and asked if there

was anyone in favor or opposition, and if there were any elected officials that would like to be heard. He closed that portion of the meeting and opened it up to the Commissioners. Commissioner Uhlman asked if they have a license? He replied, no they do not. Lt. Farrell had no objections from the Police Department. 
A motion was made by Commissioner Simpson to approve the permit. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Uhlman and made unanimous by vote of the members present.






