The reading of the minutes from September 11, 2025, meeting was waived. Motion by Neal Fama, seconded by Christopher Hill.

#### Old business:

- a. The Procurement Department is scheduled to move back to its previous location this Tuesday evening. While the Mayor and the Chief of Staff have already completed their move back to their original office, the relocation of the remaining Mayor's office staff is still underway.
- b. The go live date of January 9<sup>th</sup>, has been postponed. Currently, fixes are being addressed with City Hall Systems and Sensus. The committee will determine a revised go live date soon. The universal cutover will include new modules for specific departments, while all other features will remain identical.
- c. The Assessor's Department is aiming for a cloud migration as part of their FY 27 budget. Meanwhile, the Fire Department's transition is pending the completion of the MUNIS cutover.
- d. Relocation for the Fire Department began this week, with BEMA scheduled to move personnel over the next two weeks. While the Police & Fire radio system are not yet operational, the Police Administrative staff are anticipated to move during the last week of January.
